

Collective Statement in response to Leana Wen, MD, MSc as Speaker for the 2022 American Public Health Association Annual Meeting in Boston, MA

As public health practitioners, educators, students, advocates, and allies, we are deeply concerned about the decision to make Leana Wen, MD, MSc a speaker for the 2022 American Public Health Association (APHA) Annual Meeting. Currently, Dr. Wen is slated to be a speaker presenting on “Backlash,” and particularly regarding misinformation. We are demanding our colleagues and fellow leaders in public health to reconsider and replace Dr. Wen with someone whose work is consistent with anti-racist, anti-eugenicist public health practices and community health.

Through her platform on news outlets and social media, Dr. Wen has promoted [unscientific](#), [unsafe](#), [ableist](#), [fatphobic](#), and [unethical](#) practices during the COVID-19 pandemic. For instance, in a recent article, Dr. Wen suggested that [infection should be accepted](#) as a “[new normal](#).” In another article, she writes about how [learning loss is a threat to children](#) from parents who want to keep their kids safe; despite the fact that as of 8/6/2022, [1,376 children have died from COVID-19 infection](#). In yet another article, she advocated for “[hot vax spring](#),” suggesting - while still in an omicron surge - that municipalities lift all protections except vaccination. Her recommendations also included the unscientific and nonsensical suggestion of [designating a section of planes to wearing masks](#) in response to an airborne pathogen.

Her repeated statements are [antagonistic](#) to and [diminish](#) the hard work of APHA members and colleagues who have had to deal with the fallout of [her messaging](#), some of whom have experienced compounded harm from being disabled and/or immunocompromised. Indeed, instead of listening to those most at-risk and most harmed by her words, Dr. Wen has famously [blocked disabled activists](#) and [public health experts](#) on social media.

Though it would be sufficient to disinvite Dr. Wen for an APHA keynote based on her statements during the COVID-19 pandemic alone, her record as President of Planned Parenthood Federation of America (PPFA), a position [from which she was fired](#), should also be considered as further rationale, particularly during this political moment. During her tenure as President of PPFA, Dr. Wen was directly responsible for creating and enabling [abusive conditions](#) under which staffers left in mass exodus. As we sit at a moment where abortion access is under direct threat, with [multiple states banning abortion with limited exception](#), it is important to point out that Dr. Wen’s [leadership failure](#) and [unwillingness to address abortion’s political nature](#) [empowered attacks on abortion to escalate](#) to the point we see today.

APHA’s decision to make Dr. Wen a keynote speaker and further platform her as a leader within public health is a tacit endorsement of ideologies that run counter to best, evidence-based practices in public health, including the precautionary principle. We are not a field driven by individual risk and medicalization; our mission is to uphold the public’s health and collective well-being using science and evidence-based decision-making towards health equity—the same values APHA purports as an organization. We, the signers, do not believe that Dr. Wen upholds these values and we believe the evidence we have provided supports this belief.

Our objection to Dr. Wen as a keynote speaker is not solely based on what she has said and done, but also because we believe that APHA, as the foremost and largest public health organization in the United States, has an obligation to consider the ways that platforming her as a public health leader lends credence to her harmful messaging. Public health as a discipline has a history of paternalism, eugenics, and racism, and we are seeing first-hand that these issues need to be reckoned with. By uplifting Dr. Wen, who believes that “learning loss” is a fate worse than death and that individual risk should guide pandemic decision-making among leaders, what does this say about APHA and the entire public health discipline? What does it say about public health that APHA is choosing to support someone who created abusive working conditions, driving out the experts within the field? Why is this the person APHA wants to talk about “backlash,” rather than the public health workers who lived it for the last two years? And how much of APHA membership fees, many paid by those who have been directly harmed by Dr. Wen’s messaging, is going towards the [\\$30,000 speaker fee](#) Dr. Wen charges?

The 2022 keynote is an opportunity for APHA, the foremost and largest public health organization in the United States, to reject the history of paternalism, eugenics, and racism and to begin rebuilding a relationship with the public we serve. The start of a new relationship with the public can and should start with us.

Thus, we demand that APHA:

1. rescinds the invitation for Dr. Leana Wen’s keynote
2. replace Dr. Leana Wen as keynote with someone who is capable and can speak to evidence-based practices rooted in a collective responsibility for health equity
3. publicly rejects the rhetoric of inevitable mass infection
